

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS
TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENTS
SAN ANTONIO ROAD and FIRST STREET/CUESTA DRIVE

- Description of Work:** The City of Los Altos, Santa Clara County, California, invites sealed proposals or bids for furnishing labor, material and equipment required to complete the project in the particular locations, of the forms, sizes and dimensions and of the materials and to the lines and grades and at the elevations as shown and delineated upon the plans and specifications made therefore. The following information is presented to indicate the size of the project and no warrant is made or intended to final quantities:

The project includes but is not limited to mobilization, traffic control, permanent roadway stripes and markings, traffic signal modifications, fiber optic signal interconnect system, and all other items or details not mentioned above that are required by the Contract Specifications to complete the project as shown on the plan and specifications.

- Location of Work:** All of said work is to be done at the intersection of San Antonio Road and First Street/Cuesta Drive and signal interconnect conduit and fiber optic cable to Foothill Expressway/San Antonio Road traffic signal cabinet as indicated on the plans and in accordance with these specifications
- Contract Documents:** A copy of the exhibits and specifications shall be obtained from the office of the City Engineer, City Hall, 1 North San Antonio Road, Los Altos, California, 94022 for a non-refundable fee of \$40 or visit City website to download the PDF file(s) (<http://bids.losaltosca.gov>). Copy may also be inspected at the office of the City Engineer.
- Labor Compliance.** Pursuant to paragraph 7-1.01A, Labor Code Requirements, of the General Provisions in these specifications, Contractor is required to comply with California Labor Code Section 1770, et seq. This Code requires the Contractor to pay their workers based on prevailing wage rates established and issued by the Department of Industrial Relations, Division of Labor and Statistics and Research.

Pursuant to SB 854, all contractors or subcontractors bidding on public works projects must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR). No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project (submitted on or after March 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].

No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project (awarded on or after April 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

5. **Pre-bid Site Review:** A pre-bid conference is not scheduled for this project. Prospective bidders are directed to Section 2-1.03 of the Standard Specifications regarding examination of the site of work.
6. **Contractor's License:** The Contractor is required to have a class A General Engineering and class C-10 Electrical Contractor for this work. All bidders shall be licensed under the provisions of Chapter 9, Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California to do the type of work contemplated in the project.
7. **Location of Bid Submittal and Date and Time of Opening:** Said sealed proposals shall be delivered to the City Engineer of said City on or before

2:00 p.m., Tuesday, September 1, 2015

at City Hall, 1 North San Antonio Road, Los Altos, CA. Proposals received will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time.

8. **Award of Contract:** Said bids will be presented to and considered by the City Council at a regularly scheduled meeting.
9. **Time of Completion of Work:** The work shall be completed and ready for full use within **one hundred and twenty (120) calendar days**, the first day of which shall be the date specified in the City Engineer's "Notice to Proceed". The daily working hours are restricted from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM during which roadway traffic is impacted. All other work that does not impeach into the roadway traffic can start from 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM.
10. **Rights of the City:** The City reserves the right to cancel the project, and to reject any or all bids if not satisfied as to the price for the work or the responsibility of the bidder. The City also reserves the right to waive any informalities according to law.
11. **Project Administration:** All questions relative to this project prior to the opening of bids shall be in writing and directed to the City Engineer, City of Los Altos, 1 North San Antonio Rd., Los Altos, CA, 94022.

Special direction is directed to Section 2 of the General Provisions for full directions as to bidding.
